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Costume Info



Where do I find my costume details?

As costumes arrive and are finalized, your parent portal will be updated with the color and brand of tights, hairstyles, and shoes.

It is important to purchase the correct color and brand of tights for each costume in order to create a unifed look.

Where can I purchase tights?

FootLites carries the tights needed for all classes. You may also purchase on your own. We do our best to keep sizes in stock. However, it will dwindle as we get closer to performances and picture week.

How do I keep my costumes organized?

We suggest keeping all costumes in an organized garmet bag. Garmet bags with pockets to hold accessories, and shoes are very helpful. We do have these in stock for \$16.95.

Parade Check in and Check out

Dancers will meet in the parking lot south of Tree Top at Jim Clements Way and 5th. PARENTS, please park in the empty lot next to Selah Vision Clinic and walk dancers over to us.

DE Competition Dancers will need to arrive at 8:20 for judging. All other FL dancers will need to arrive between 9-9:15am.

Dancers will need to be picked up when FootLites has arrived at the end of the parade: The back side of Grocery Outlet.

A detailed and quick youtube video will be sent out for clarification.

Parade Route

The Parade will head down Jim Clements Way and finish up at Banner Bank. HOWEVER, please follow us and pick up your dancer behind Grocery Outlet. For the safety of the kids, we will NOT let kids go at Banner Bank.

Reminder: All dancers will need to be checked out AFTER we are finished, not at the end of the entire parade.




Parents Drop Off

Picture Week Schedule

A picture week schedule is in the works and will emailed out, posted to your parent portal under the Files Tab and on our website soon. There will be no dance classes this week unless your instructor has said otherwise.

Where are the photos taken & how do I purchase?

All photos will be taken at FootLites in Studio A. These are closed to parents. All payments will be made to HK Photography. Photo forms to fill out will be emailed out with additional copies at the front desk.

Does my dancer need to be there if I am not purchasing any photos?

All dancers are encouraged to attend their photo time to be in the group photo that will be displayed on our wall next season. For individual pictures, All dancers will choose 2 poses for each costume with instructor guidance. Buddy & Sibling Photos are an option if purchasing them.

What is hair and makeup for Dance Photos?

Costume details will be emailed out and posted on your parent portal as we get closer to picture week. We do encourage all dancers to wear a little bit of makeup so they are not washed out in the photos. Parents may use discretion. We suggest mascara, blush, lip gloss or lipstick and whatever else you are comfortable with.

When are my photos available for pick up?

Photos will be available for pickup mid summer at FootLites. An email along with a Facebook post will go out once available.

Recital Ticketing Part 1

Is the Capitol Theatre General Admission Seating?

No. Tickets are all numbered seats and the seating chart can be found online at www.capitoltheatre.org

How and where do I purchase my tickets?

Tickets will go on sale Monday, May 15th at 11am -4pm and are \$20 each plus a Theatre patron charge of \$2.00.

You can purchase tickets one of 3 ways:

- 2. Call the Box Office at: 509-853-2787. (11am-4pm M-Fri)
- 3. Purchase at the Box Office: 19 S 3rd St (11am-4pm M-Fri)

NO TICKETS ARE SOLD AT FOOTLITES

Do I need a ticket for my 3 and under child?

If your infant/child sits on a lap and doesn't take a seat, they will not need a ticket.

Do I need a ticket if I am with my child backstage?

If you plan on entering the Theatre, you do need a ticket to enter.

Do I need a ticket if I plan on being backstage the entire time of the show with my child?

No. There will also be a live stream to in the backstage changing area to watch.

Recital Ticketing

Part 2

What if I have siblings that are split between 2 shows?

You will receive 3 complimentary tickets for one show. An email will be sent to all families that recieve a comp ticket prior to ticket sales.

What if I have a dancer performing the same routine in 2 shows and why?

If your dancer is performing a routine in both shows, you will receive a complimentary ticket for the repeat show. Why both shows? This is to help with keeping as many dancers routines in one show and eliminate families attending and purchasing tickets 2 shows.

How do I recieve my complimentary tickets?

A list will be emailed to those eligible families with details. The Theatre Box Office will have the list we have provided and these seats will need to be chosen through the box office, in person or over the phone. This can not be done online.

Are my tickets / seats valid for both shows?

Tickets purchased are only valid for the show time they were purchased for and can not be used for another show. You will need seperate tickets for both shows.

Dress Rehearsals

Thursday, June 15th

Show 1: MANDATORY Full Dress Rehearsal @ Capitol Theatre Dancers arrive in first costume at 4pm.

Rehearsal will run 4:30 - 8:00pm hopefully earlier

Dress Rehearsal is full hair, makeup, costumes, and props.

We will run Finale (final bow) first followed by show order. When your dancer is done rehearsing, they are allowed to leave.

Friday, June 16th

Show 2: MANDATORY Full Dress Rehearsal @ Capitol Theatre. Dancers arrive in first costume at 4pm.

Rehearsal will run 4:30 - 8:00pm hopefully earlier

Dress Rehearsal is full hair, makeup, costumes, and props.
We will run Finale (final bow) first followed by show order. When your dancer is done rehearsing, they are allowed to leave.

If your routine is a "repeat" from the 1st show, we will NOT rehearse it during this rehearsal unless needed.

Per Capitol Theatre restrictions, one parent/guardian per dancer. That one parent is allowed in the front of the house (theatre seats) during dress rehearsal. No "extra" family members are permitted. If possible, please leave other siblings at home. Females only will be allowed for female dancers in the dressing room. Our boys have a seperate area for changing.



Saturday, June 17th

11:30 AM SHOW:

Dancers will need to be at the Theatre by 10:30am and will need to enter through the 4th Street Entrance, behind the Capitol Theatre.

Dancers will need to be dressed in their 1st costume, ready by 11:00am. The show will begin promptly at 11:30am.

All Dancers, Parents and FootLites Staff will need to leave the building in between shows. Costumes and belongings can stay if you're in the 5:30pm show.

5:30 PM SHOW:

Dancers will need to be at the Theatre by 4:30 pm and will need to enter through the 4th Street Entrance, behind the Capitol Theatre.

Dancers will need to be dressed in their 1st costume, ready by 5:00pm. The show will begin promptly at 5:30pm.

BOTH SHOWS:

1 Female Parent per dancer will be allowed backstage.
Upon leaving the 4th St entrance, you will be given a backstage pass to allow you back into the changing area. All passes must be returned upon re-entering. If you are planning on entering the Theatre, you will need a ticket. Please view our ticketing page for details.

Recital Day Details

Why we encourage makeup!

Your dancer will be performing on a large stage in a wonderful show! The Theatre will have a large stage with lots of bright lights. A little bit of makeup helps them to not look washed out on stage, in photos and in the video. Parents discretion on the amount used and we treat this as a "special occassion." Our boys typically do not wear makeup.

Can I take photos/videos during the performance?

Yes! You can take photos/video without a flash. Check out our Recital Optionals Page for more info on our professional videographer.

Front Row Of Theatre Reserved

The front row is reserved for photo and video taking of your child during their performance. Please be mindful of other parents and courteous of other attendees.

Show Etiquette

Please remind famly members to be courteous of other dancers that are on stage and remain in their seat during performances. Applause throughout the performances is encouraged. There is no food or drink in the Theatre.
